IV. Agenda Items**Ordinances**

3887-08 An Ordinance of the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, amending and supplementing the Allegheny County Code of Ordinances, Division 1, entitled "Administrative Code," through the creation of a new Article 705, entitled "Parks," in order to provide a mechanism for exploring and accomplishing the privatization of one or more of the County Parks.

Sponsors: Matt Drozd

Summary: *Mr. Drozd provided the committee with a summary of the bill. He said that the bill would grant authority to the County Manager to create a policy for establishing public-private partnerships within Allegheny County Parks.*

He said that the policy would include provisions for public-private partnerships for the operation of one or more County Parks, as well as for operation of individual sites or services.

Mr. Baechle said that the Parks Department is already in the process of establishing some private/public partnerships for some parks, and may extend that. Mr. Drozd said that he would like to hold the bill and meet with Mr. Baechle to discuss this. Mr. Baechle agreed to that.
