Section 1. The County Council of Allegheny County approves the amendments to the Allegheny County 2021 Grants and Special Accounts Budget as set forth in Attachment A.


Section 2. The line item detail of the appropriations approved by Council shall be amended as reflected on Attachment A hereto, the provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION / NECESSITY

This is additional grant funding from the Office of Justice Programs of the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD) to support local law enforcement and law enforcement partners of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to prevent, prepare for and respond to the COVID-19 pandemic. These funds, in addition to the original grant allocation, will be used to acquire new electronic monitoring (EM) devices for Adult Probation to expand EM probation. This will allow for further reduction of jail population, which will help continuing mitigation efforts related to coronavirus.
