A Resolution of the County of Allegheny amending the Grants and Special Accounts Budget for 2009 (Submission #09-09).

The Council of the County of Allegheny hereby resolves as follows:


Section 1. The County Council of Allegheny County approves the amendments to the Allegheny County 2009 Grants and Special Accounts Budget as set forth in Attachment A.
