Ordinance

2324-06 An Ordinance repealing the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Parks,

Recreation and Conservation as established by Ordinance on January 1, 1977 and amended by Ordinance on June 14, 1982 to aid in the preservation of County property and promoting and preserving the public health, safety and welfare in the parks owned and maintained by the County of Allegheny, and replacing such

Rules and Regulations with Parks Department Regulations.

Sponsors: Vince Gastgeb

Summary: The Chair indicated that there was a meeting on this bill in February and suggested

revisions have been provided to the committee. Mr. Gastgeb said that he recalled an issue regarding firearms in the parks. Mr. Baechle said that the final version of the bill contained language provided by the Law Department. Mr. Burn asked what the changes were from the original bill. Mr. Moffatt said that the County Police had some input and they felt that the county could not supersede state law on firearms. He said that if a person is licensed to carry a firearm, then they are allowed to carry in the parks. Also,

the bill would allow a person not licensed to carry to transport firearms through the park as long as it is not accessible for use.

The Chair said that the revisions will be introduced as an amendment at the March 21, 2006 Regular Meeting.

Mr. Gastgeb complimented Mr. Moffatt and the County Police for their input on this bill

Action:

Resolution

2421-06

A Resolution authorizing the Allegheny County Police Training Academy to apply for and to accept a grant from the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission (MPOETC) and agreeing to adhere to all rules, regulations and training standards established MPOETC.

Sponsors: Chief Executive

Summary:

Mr. Moffat provided a summary of the bill. He said that the bill would authorize the County to apply for and accept grant funding from the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission (MPOETC). He said that this authorization is required before the County may receive grant funding for the training of police officers under the terms of the statute that established the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training program, Act 120 of 1974.

He said that they just put on a new class of officers and that they can apply for 60% reimbursement of their salaries while they are in the academy and for all county costs associated with their training. He said they just need Council's approval before they can receive the money.

Action:

A motion was made by Gastgeb, seconded by Burn, that this matter be Affirmatively Recommended. The motion carried unanimously.
