AN ORDINANCE

An Ordinance of the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, authorizing the Department of Administrative Services, Division of Purchasing and Supplies to conduct an internet auction of a 1993 Freightliner Truck with Post Hole Digger and Drilling Attachment to the highest bidder.

Whereas, the County of Allegheny is owns a 1993 Freightliner Truck with Post Hole Digger and Drilling Attachment, which are located in the Heavy Equipment Division, District One; and

Whereas, the County has determined that this vehicle is surplus property and is no longer needed by the County for any purpose; and

Whereas, Section 5 - 701.05 of the Allegheny County Administrative Code generally provides for the sale or disposition of County property other than real estate either by public or private sale; and

Whereas, the Department of Administrative Services -- Division of Purchasing believes that the most efficient and effective method of disposal of the surplus vehicle is by public sale to the highest bidder at an auction using the Internet; and

Whereas, the Allegheny County Administrative Code requires the disposition of County-owned property through an Ordinance passed by County Council.

The Council of the County of Allegheny hereby enacts as follows:

SECTION 1. Incorporation of Preamble.

The provisions set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance are incorporated by reference in their entirety herein.

SECTION 2. Authorization to Sell Surplus Property at Internet Auction.

- A. The Department of Administrative Services -- Division of Purchasing (Hereinafter Purchasing), is hereby authorized to conduct a Public Auction sale using the Internet, of the following item of surplus County property:

One (1) 1993 Freightliner Truck with Post Hole Digger and Drilling Attachment presently located in the Heavy Equipment Division, District One. Public Works identified as follows: 1. 1993 Freightliner Truck with Post Hole Digger and Drilling Attachment, County Tag #VE9881, VIN#1FV6HFAB7PL435651.

- B. The public auction of the above-named item shall be conducted at such a time and under such terms and conditions as shall be established by Purchasing; provided however, that the minimum bid price for the item shall not be less than \$1000.
- C. Following the receipt of final bids in an amount greater than the minimum bid price set forth in Paragraph B above, Purchasing is authorized to sell the vehicle to the highest bidder.

SECTION 3. Additional Actions Authorized.


Purchasing and the County Manager are hereby authorized to take any other additional actions deemed necessary and prudent to carry out the intentions of the Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance shall be determined to be unlawful, invalid, void or unenforceable, then that provision shall be considered severable from the remaining provisions of this Ordinance which shall be in full force and effect.






