IV. Agenda Items**Ordinances**

3674-08 An Ordinance of the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, authorizing the use of approximately six acres of property by the Pennsylvania Turnpike commission in North Park.

Sponsors: Chief Executive

Summary: *Mr. Baechle provided the committee with a summary of the bill. He said that the ordinance would permit the Parks Department to lease six acres of property in North Park to the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission for the construction of a wetland mitigation site. He said that the Parks Department has recommended the approval of said property and that lease payments would not be required from the Turnpike Commission.*

He also said that the Turnpike Commission would be responsible for monitoring and maintaining the site for a period of five years or until the project is deemed a success and that the County would retain ownership of the property and would preserve the mitigation site as a wetland thereafter.

He presented a map to the committee to display the exact location of the property. He said that there is no significant liability to the county.
