



Dear Council Members:

Please find the attached resume of Ronald J. Beinlich, whom I am recommending for reappointment to the Agricultural Land Preservation Board.

The purpose of the Agricultural Land Preservation Board is to purchase the development rights of undeveloped farm land in Allegheny County. These development rights are held as easements against the property, meaning that the land cannot be developed. This board was created by state law and its activities are funded by the State. I am recommending that Mr. Beinlich serve another 3-year term ending on December 31, 2010.

Mr. Beinlich is the past director of the Pennsylvania Vegetable Growers Association, and is also involved in the North American Strawberry Growers Association, the Pennsylvania Farm Bureau, and the North American Farmers Direct Marketing Association. Mr. Beinlich is also a former member of the Forward Township Planning Commission.

I appreciate your consideration, and ask you to act on this appointment as quickly as possible. Mr. Beinlich will make himself available for review before the appropriate committee if members of Council wish to speak with him.
