


Please find the attached resume of John J. Petrolias, whom I am recommending for reappointment to the Authority for the Improvements in Municipalities.

This Authority provides low interest loans to municipal governments and authorities to help them finance various capital needs including infrastructure, equipment and buildings. Grants are available for projects that are multi-municipal in nature, or impact a county facility. AIM also has the ability to issue tax-exempt financing, administer the distribution and investment of fiduciary funds, and provide deferred loans for special project activities. I am recommending that Mr. Petrolias serve another 5 year term, which will expire on December 31, 2010.

Mr. Petrolias has served on the AIM Board since 1985, and currently serves his family owned business, the Smithfield Café, located in Downtown Pittsburgh. Mr. Petrolias is the past president of the Western Pennsylvania Restaurant Association, and also a past president of the St. Nicholas Cathedral Board of Directors.

I appreciate your consideration, and ask you to act on this appointment as quickly as possible. Mr. Petrolias will make himself available for review before the appropriate committee if members of Council wish to speak with him.
