

Dear Council Members:

Please find the attached resume of John J. Petrolias, whom I am recommending for reappointment to the Authority for the Improvements in Municipalities.

This Authority provides low interest loans to municipal governments and authorities to help them finance various capital needs including infrastructure, equipment and buildings. Grants are available for projects that are multi-municipal in nature, or impact a county facility. AIM also has the ability to issue tax-exempt financing, administer the distribution and investment of fiduciary funds, and provide deferred loans for special project activities.
