## **Marc Little**

Marc Little is the President/CEO and founder of the Minority & Women Educational Labor Agency (MWELA). In his current position Mr. Little is responsible for managing a multimillion dollar non-profit organization whose mission is to help minorities and women individuals and companies receive training, employment and bonding opportunities in the building trades industry. Since its inception, MWELA has built the Building Trades Pre-Apprenticeship Program to be one of the most successful training and education programs in the region, providing many of its participants with the education and skills required to gain entrance into the various Building Trades Union Apprenticeship Programs. The Sheltered Bond Program was started, in 2007 to provide an opportunity for minority, women and disadvantaged owned contracting companies to receive a bond for the first time on increase their current bond capacity, through a well designed, structured and monitored program. The Sheltered Bond Program is a state funded pilot program. The goal of the Sheltered Bond Program is to ensure that when contractors have successfully performed their bond they will be given the opportunity for bonding capacity at an increased amount for \$1 million or more.

With over 18 years experience in the construction industry, Mr. Little is also the owner of Lorraine Construction a general contracting firm which was incorporated in 2002 and was the inspiration for creating MWELA. Lorraine Construction is a general contracting and construction management company, specializing in commercial and residential construction. Later a division was added within the company to specialize in development packaging, financing, and program management.

Mr. Little is currently one of ten members that sit on the board of the **Equal Opportunity Review Commission**, which oversees all city contracts in amounts of 200,000 or more and reviews contracts of 25,000. In addition, Mr. Little sits on the **Diversity Committee** for 16 billion of federal stimulus package money, of which was developed by the Legislative Black Caucus.

Mr. Little is a graduate of the Institute for Entrepreneurial Excellence at the Katz School of Business, University of Pittsburgh and resides in Collier Township with his wife and two children.
