Ordinance

3746-08

An Ordinance of the County of Allegheny amending Article XXI of the Allegheny County Health Department's Rules and Regulations, "Air Pollution Control Regulations and Addition to State Implementation Plan, modifying Section 2104.02, which will change the particulate emissions limitations for the US Steel Clairton Works' Coke Screening #3 process.

Sponsors: Chief Executive

Summary:

Dr. Dixon provided the committee with a brief summary of the bill. He then deferred to Mr. Thompson who provided a more detailed explanation. He said that the bill would amend the Allegheny County Health Department's Air to change the particulate emissions limitations for the US Steel Clairton Works' Coke Screening #3 process.

He said that the only change to the regulation would be to the amount of PM-10 emissions that would be permissible for this particular process. As currently written, the regulation specifies that PM-10 emissions cannot exceed 2.8 grains/ton of coke at any time. The amendment would change this to a maximum of 1.26 pounds per hour.

He said that the limit of 2.8 grains PM10 per ton of coke was developed during the PM-10 State Implementation Plan in the early 1990's. A baghouse is the particulate control device used to control emissions from this process. He said that analysis of the process since the PM-10 SIP found that this limit is physically infeasible for any baghouse. It has been determined that the Article XXI limit is the result of an error in calculations or in efficiency estimations.

He said that a new baghouse has been proposed for installation at the Coke Screening #3 process and that no significant impact at any location adjacent to the Clairton Works.

Action: A motion was made by Cleary, seconded by Futules, that this matter be Affirmatively Recommended. The motion carried unanimously.
