







Dear Council Members:

Please find the attached resume of Regis R. Claus, whom I am recommending for reappointment to the Plumbing Advisory Board.

The Plumbing Advisory Board was established by Article XV, Plumbing, Rules and Regulations of the Allegheny County Health Dept. This Board shall strive continually to prevent public health hazards through improper plumbing installations and promote sound plumbing practices. I am recommending that Mr. Claus serve another 3 year term, which will expire on December 31, 2010.

Mr. Claus is currently the Building Industry representative on the Plumbing Advisory Board.
