statement, the borrowing base certificate to be appended to the debt statement, and other appropriate documents required by the local government unit debt act [53 Pa.C.S.A §8001 et seq.]; issuing, upon receipt of approval of the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development, the guaranty; authorizing delivery of the guaranty to the trustee under a trust indenture; specifying the amount of the guaranty obligations of the County pursuant to the guaranty; guaranteeing replenishment of the debt service reserve fund in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$2,600,000 and making certain covenants with respect thereto; authorizing the execution and delivery of a reimbursement agreement and related documents; and providing for proper officers of the County to take all other required, necessary or desirable related action in connection with said project.
