The Council President shall appoint a Presiding Officer for the public hearing; take appropriate steps to provide for security for the public hearing, and determine if transcription of the testimony given is appropriate.


Individuals wishing to speak must register 24 hours in advance with the Chief Clerk of Allegheny County Council in accordance with the rules governing public comment at Council meetings.


