RESOLUTION

A Resolution of the County of Allegheny amending the Grants and Special Accounts Budget for 2009 (Submission #10-09).

Whereas, the County Council has adopted Grants for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2009 and ending December 31, 2009; and

Whereas, at the request of the County's Department of Budget and Finance, County Council desires to amend the 2009 Grants Budget.

The Council of the County of Allegheny hereby resolves as follows:

Section 1. The County Council of Allegheny County approves the amendments to the Allegheny County 2009 Grants and Special Accounts Budget as set forth in Attachment A.

Section 2. The line item detail of the appropriations approved by Council shall be amended as reflected on Attachment A hereto, the provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference.



NEW--American Recovery & Reinvestment Act of 2009 - Stimulus Funds - Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program. Funds to provide financial assistance and services to prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless and help those who have become homeless to be stabilized and quickly re-housed. Eligible activities include short-term or long-term rental assistance and housing relocation and stabilization services. At least 60% of the funds must be spent within two years and all of the funds in three years. Grantees and subgrantees may use up to 5% of the funds for management and oversight of the programs, grants, and activities funded under the appropriation. Allegheny County & the City of Pittsburgh will be implementing a joint program.

NEW--American Recovery & Reinvestment Act of 2009 - Stimulus Funds - Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG). The purpose of the EECBG Program is to assist eligible entities in creating and implementing strategies to:

- reduce fossil fuel emissions in a manner that is environmentally sustainable and maximizes benefits for local and regional communities; reduce the total energy use of the eligible entities; and improve energy efficiency in the building sector, the transportation sector, and other appropriate sectors. Additional purposes of the EECBG Program are to spur economic growth and create and/or retain jobs under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.
