RESOLUTION

Resolution adopting the Grants, Special Accounts and Agency Fund Budgets for County Fiscal year beginning January 1, 2003, and ending December 31, 2003.

Be it resolved by the Council of Allegheny County that the following budgets are adopted for calendar year 2003 as follows:

- **Section 1.** The Grants Budget totaling \$613,099,985 in accordance with the line item appropriation of each project is attached as Appendix A. The Budget represents previously approved and currently active grants awarded to Allegheny County.
- **Section 2.** Special Accounts appropriations totaling \$45,651,513 in accordance with the line item appropriation of each project is attached as Appendix B.
- **Section 3.** An Agency Fund Budget representing an allocation of the estimated Hotel Room Rental Tax available to fund the Sports & Exhibition Authority in the amount of \$1,977,158.
- **Section 4.** The detailed allocation contained in these three budgets shall be conveyed to the County Executive and County Controller.
- **Section 5.** Increases in any project allocation intended during the course of calendar year 2003 will be considered as a budget amendment and must be presented to Council as a resolution amending the budget. Decreases in funding due to discontinuance of grants or failure of projected revenues to materialize require notification to Council. New projects initiated during the year require Council approval of budgets prior to expenditure.

I transmit herewith a copy of the following legislation which was passed in Council on December 3, 2002. As indicated in a memo dated December 18, 2002, from Council's Chief of Staff/Budget Director Guy Tumolo to all Row Officers, at the Regular Meeting of Council held on December 17, 2002, Council did not accept the Chief Executive's veto based on the advice of counsel that the veto was defective as to form since it did not comply with the requirements for a veto as set forth in the County Charter and Administrative Code.

Accordingly, it is the position of the majority of the seated Members of Council that since there was no properly constructed veto submitted within the requisite time period, the budget that was passed on December 3, 2002, is the official 2003 County Budget.
