Edward Kress Sponsors:

Summary:

The chair indicated that this legislation had been under development for about a month, and deferred to Mr. Kress.

Mr. Kress discussed the effect of the most recent round of amendments to this bill.

Mr. Jabbour suggested holding the bill in order to consider further refinements, and indicated that he would not want to see the bill defeated simply because it was rushed.

An additional amendment was added such that applicants for contractor licensing would certify that they will notify employers of the license status of all subcontractors.
