AN ORDINANCE

An Ordinance of the County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, authorizing the use of Hartwood by the United Steel Workers of America for the purpose of hosting an event entitled, "Stand Up For Steel" in support of the steel industry.

WHEREAS, the County of Allegheny (hereinafter referred to as "County") owns and operates certain recreational and park facilities including the facilities known as Hartwood; and

WHEREAS, the United Steel Workers of America have requested that they be permitted to use the facilities at Hartwood to host "Stand Up For Steel" an event which will provide music, entertainment and refreshments for those interested in supporting the Steel Industry, and the County wishes to permit the use of Hartwood for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, Article IV, Sections 2.b and 2.k. of the Allegheny Home Rule Charter vests the County's Council with the power to permit the use of County land, buildings or other real or personal property.

The Council of the County of Allegheny hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1

The provisions set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance are incorporated by reference in their entirety herein.

Section 2.

County Council does hereby authorize the use of Hartwood by the United Steel Workers of America for the purpose of hosting an event entitled, "Stand Up For Steel" to gather support for the United States steel industry. The event will take place on September 20, 2003. Requirements for such use shall be as determined by the Allegheny County Parks Department. The appropriate County officers and officials are authorized to take such action as is necessary to carry out the purposes of the authorization granted herein.

Section 3.

Admission to the general public is free of charge and the presenters will pay all costs associated with this event.


SECTION 4. *If any provision of this Ordinance shall be determined to be unlawful, invalid, void or unenforceable, then that provision shall be considered severable from the remaining provisions of this Ordinance which shall be in full force and effect.*

SECTION 5. *Any Resolution or Ordinance or part thereof conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed so far as the same affects this Ordinance.*
