RESOLUTION

A Resolution of the County of Allegheny amending the Grants and Special Accounts Budget for 2026 (Submission #04-26).

Whereas, the County Council has adopted a Grants and Special Accounts Budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2026, and ending December 31, 2026; and

Whereas, at the request of the County's Department of Budget and Finance, County Council desires to amend the 2026 Grants and Special Account Budget.

The Council of the County of Allegheny hereby resolves as follows:

SECTION 1. Approval.

This County Council of Allegheny County approves the amendments to the Allegheny County 2026 Grants and Special Accounts Budget as set forth in Attachment A.

SECTION 2. Amendment.

The line item detail of the appropriations approved by Council shall be amended as reflected on Attachment A hereto, the provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 3. Effective Date and Term of this Ordinance.

This Resolution will enter into effect immediately upon its approval.

SECTION 4. Severability.

If any provision of this Ordinance shall be determined to be unlawful, invalid, void or unenforceable, then that provision shall be considered severable from the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, which shall be in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. Repealer.

Any Resolution or Ordinance or part thereof conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed so far as the same affects this Ordinance.

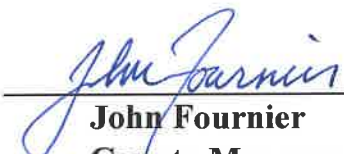
