





## MEMORANDUM

**Subject:** Councilman Kendrick's Letter of Resignation

Attached is a letter of resignation addressed to Council President Rick Schwartz submitted to me today by Councilman Kendrick. As you will read, Councilman Kendrick indicated that his resignation took effect at the conclusion of the Regular Meeting of Council held on September 9, 2003. In the past, Council approved a motion to accept resignations of former Council Members. You may do so at the next Regular Meeting of Council scheduled for September 23, 2003.

As you are aware, Article III Section 9 of the Home Rule Charter governs the process regarding a vacancy of a Council seat. It states that if a Council seat becomes vacant, Members of Council shall appoint an interim Council Member within 30 days. The interim Council Member shall have the same political party affiliation as the former Council Member. If Council fails to appoint a replacement within 30 days, the Court of Common Pleas may appoint one if a petition containing 100 signatures is submitted to the court requesting the court to do so.

The interim Council Member shall hold the vacated seat until the vacancy is filled at the next available municipal election which is scheduled for November 4, 2003.
