Anthony W. Saveikis attended Washington & Jefferson College in Washington, PA, graduating in 1989. From there he furthered his education in Columbus, Ohio at Capital University Law School, earning his J.D. in 1993. At this time, Saveikis was admitted to the Pennsylvania Bar Association (1993) and in April 1995 was admitted to the United States District Court.

Saveikis was elected in 2001, and reelected in 2007, as Magisterial District Judge, serving the communities of North Fayette Township, Findlay Township, Oakdale, McDonald, and the Pittsburgh International Airport. This region is Allegheny County's largest district and consistently among the top five busiest courts. In addition to his Magisterial position he has been of Counsel at *Jones, Gregg, Creehan, & Gerace* since 2004. Prior to Saveikis' current role as District Judge, he was in private practice with a focus in real estate transactions as well as, land use, zoning, planning, residential and commercial development, including projects with the Allegheny County Airport Authority, the RIDC, and longtime client C.B.
