Bob Hurley joined Allegheny County Economic Development June 2004 and was appointed Director of Allegheny County Economic Development (ACED) in January 2015. In this position, Mr. Hurley also serves as Director of the Allegheny County Redevelopment Authority and Executive Director of the Authority for Improvement in Municipalities, Industrial Development Authority, Hospital Development Authority, Higher Education Building Authority, and Residential Finance Authority. Mr. Hurley is responsible for the overall development and implementation of the economic development strategy for Allegheny County. He manages funding from local, state, and federal resources to implement economic development activities such as: site development, new job creation initiatives, community development, and affordable housing for approximately 1.25 million citizens in 130 municipalities, as well oversees the department's 75 employees.

In Mr. Hurley's prior role as ACED's Sr. Deputy Director, he was responsible for expanding and attracting businesses and creating jobs in Allegheny County; overseeing government business loan and grant programs; managing the Allegheny County Planning Agency, directing the development and redevelopment of County brownfields and other sites; and guiding housing development through local, state, and federal programs.

Mr. Hurley began his government career in environmental, community, and land use planning. He worked with the Urban Redevelopment Authority of Pittsburgh, where he oversaw housing development proposals, including initial financing through build-out and sale, and also worked in the City of Pittsburgh Mayor's Office as Manager of Economic Development. Additionally, he was with the Pittsburgh Technology Council, a regional trade association representing more than 1,400 technology concerns in Southwestern Pennsylvania.

Currently, Mr. Hurley serves as the Chairman of the Board of the Port Authority of Allegheny County, which provides public transportation services throughout Pittsburgh and Allegheny County via a fleet of 700 buses, 83 light rail vehicles, and 2 inclines. Additionally, he sits on the Southwestern Pennsylvania Commission's Regional Policy Advisory Committee, the Pittsburgh Regional Alliance Steering Committee, Immigrant Community Blueprint's Steering Committee, and Indiana University of Pennsylvania's Pittsburgh Regional Advisory Committee; is a Carnegie Mellon University Center for Economic Development Fellow; and serves as a board member of Urban Innovation21, a public-private partnership that boosts regional economic development through 21st century innovation-driven entrepreneurship within the City of Pittsburgh.

Mr. Hurley received both his MS and BA Degrees in Geography and Regional Planning from Indiana University of Pennsylvania. Additionally, he completed course work toward a second MS Degree in Public Administration with Pennsylvania State University and earned a Certificate in Community Development from the John F. Kennedy School, Harvard University.
