6133-11 An Ordinance amending the Allegheny County Code of Ordinances, Division 1,

entitled "Administrative Code," Article 808.A, in order to reduce the rate of County taxation on the sale at retail of liquor and malt and brewed beverages within the County to five percent (5%).
