#### Resolutions

<u>11231-19</u> A Resolution of the County of Allegheny amending the Grants and Special Accounts Budget for 2019 (Submission #06-19).

### <u>Sponsors:</u> Chief Executive

At the request of the Chair, the clerk read the title of the bill and Mr. McKain summarized its provisions, noting that the proposed grant is for just over \$1.5 million from the Pennsylvania Department of State to aid in the purchase of new voting machines certified for use by the Commonwealth. Mr. McKain indicated that negotiations with the chosen vendor are ongoing, with a total cost for the purchase expected to be approximately \$12 million. Mr. McKain also noted that a capital appropriation was made in 2006 for voting machine upgrades and that there is approximately \$3 million remaining under that appropriation that could be put towards the purchase. Mr. McKain also indicated that there will also be an operating budget impact resulting from the purchase, because paper ballots require more pens, tables, chairs, and other supplies that will be used in the physical process of voting, and that there will be training and education costs associated with the switch to the new machines, as well as potentially different staffing needs and the need to pay for any result audits.

A motion was made by Macey, seconded by Zavarella, that this matter be Affirmatively Recommended. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.
