He organized a spaghetti dinner at a local church, raised more than \$1,000 to purchase ukuleles and trained five volunteers to help teach the class. The six students in the class ranged in age from 15 to 20, with varying degrees of visual impairment, and each student graduated from the program with a ukulele to take home. Throughout his participation in the Boy Scouts, Mr. Steve R. Barton has set a high standard of commitment and fervor that the youth of our great county may follow. He serves as an inspiration to this Council and to the citizens of Allegheny County.
