Proclamation congratulating New Life Family Worship Center upon the occasion of its 10th anniversary.

**WHEREAS, *New Life Family Worship Center***, located in the Brighton Heights Neighborhood of the Northside in the City of Pittsburgh, stands as a pillar for the local community, providing service ministries and spiritual guidance to generations of individuals and families; and

**WHEREAS, *New Life Family Worship Center***, originally named New Life Christian Ministries was organized on March 28, 2010, at Hosanna House in Wilksburg; and

**WHEREAS**, in March 2010, Pastor James O. Edwell, now Suffragan Bishop Elect, became the first pastor of the newly organized church and has served for the past ten years. The congregation consisted of 15 members including, his wife, First Lady Dianne Edwell, Brother Ernst Moore, Sister Adele Moore, Prophetess Celeste Ellis, his devoted sister, Pastor Sheila Rawlings. Sister Meloney Dennis was the first member to join the new ministry; and

**WHEREAS**, dedicated to servicing the community, ***New Life Family Worship Center*** sponsors a variety of programs to assist and provide services to those in need throughout the community. The following are some of the programs implemented by the church and its congregation to aid those seeking assistance: Annual Back To School Rally, Children’s Church, Gospel Sing-off Competition, pulpit exchanges with numerous churches, Kingdom Seekers, (a program that teaches young believers to be leaders and grow in their walk with God) ministry in the Northview Heights Community; and

**WHEREAS**, Pastor Marvin Rawlings felt the call to serve under Pastor James Edwell in ministry in the early years of ***New Life Family Worship Center*** and was installed as Assistant Pastor of ***New Life Family Worship Center*** by Bishop John T. Leslie in March of 2012. During that time, Pastor Larry Scott was consecrated as an Associate Pastor and Minister of Music at ***New Life Family Worship Center*** where they served faithfully until they received a calling to start their own ministries in Homewood and Washington, PA; and

**WHEREAS**, Allegheny County Council is proud to recognize ***New Life Family Worship Center*** for celebrating its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary on Friday, March 26 through Sunday, March 29, 2020 at the churches home at 1301 Davis Avenue. The church along with pastor, James O. Edwell, continues to be instrumental in serving the residents of this county through education, spiritual guidance, social service, nurturing, outreach and worship;
