Proclamation commending *Local Government Academy* for being recognized as an Annual Governor's Awardee for Local Government Excellence.

WHEREAS, every year, the Governor Tom Wolf Administration recognizes municipalities and local government officials with the Annual Governor's Awards for Local Government Excellence; and

WHEREAS, the 25th Annual Governor's Awards for Local Government Excellence recognizes municipalities and local government officials for their dedication and commitment to strengthen their communities and better serve their residents; and
