WHEREAS, founded in 1972, the Pittsburgh Black Nurses in Action (PBNIA), the local chapter of the National Black Nurses Association (NBNA), are guided by the National Association's founding principal that African American nurses possess the understanding, knowledge, interest, concern, and expertise to make a difference in the health care status of African American communities across the country; and

WHEREAS, the local activities of the PBNIA include participation in outreach and community activities that are organized and executed for the purposes of providing health education, supporting health promotion, preventing disease, and empowering individuals to become their own healthcare advocates; and
