Proclamation recognizing the **4-H** program for helping young people learn leadership skills and revolutionize how youth connect to learning experiences outside the classroom.

WHEREAS, over 100 years ago, the **4-H** program began with the mission to help young people develop leadership skills and revolutionize how youth connect to practical, hands-on learning experiences outside the classroom; and

WHEREAS, **4-H** is a national program that helps young people develop knowledge and skills to become capable, caring and contributing citizens. As of today, over 6 million young people across America have participated in the 4-H program. Membership in **4-H** is open to all youth, ages of 5 to 19, without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, gender, disability, sexual orientation, or marital/parental status; and

WHEREAS, the program is dedicated to helping youth share work together in all kinds of projects, events and activities through local clubs, special interest groups, school-based and after-school programs and individual memberships; and

WHEREAS, the **4-H Club** is composed of the following: West Allegheny-community club and dairy, Pittsburgh Urban Christian School-in-school science, cooking, small animal, and chicken, E-Day-community science club, North Ridge Riders- horse, and Manely Horses-horse;
