WHEREAS, People Concerned for the Unborn Child (PCUC) is a volunteer-led organization in the Brookline neighborhood of the City of Pittsburgh that is dedicated to acting on behalf of all innocent life threatened by abortion, infanticide and euthanasia; and

**WHEREAS**, founded in 1969 in the kitchen of Mary Winter, **PCUC** works tirelessly to affirm that the unborn child is a human being entitled to the same rights as all other Americans; and

*WHEREAS*, over the past 50 years, *PCUC* has been devoted to educating and raising awareness among the citizens of Allegheny County about the right to life through their newsletter, hosting prayer vigils, and providing support for expectant mothers and infants in need; and

WHEREAS, every January, *PCUC* travels on their own time and at their own expense to Washington, D.C. to protest the Supreme Court's decision, *Roe v. Wade*. By participating in the March for Life, *PCUC* is hopeful that the decision will be overturned and another trip to the United States Capitol will be unnecessary;
