**WHEREAS**, the *Order of DeMolay* is an international youth organization sponsored by the Masonic fraternity that builds character and leadership skills in young men between the ages of 12 and 21; and

**WHEREAS**, the *Order of DeMolay* was founded in 1919 in Kansas City, Missouri, by a Kansas City area Mason, Frank S. Land, who selected the name to honor Jacques DeMolay, the last Grand Master of the Knights Templar in France; and

**WHEREAS**, the *Templar Chapter Order of DeMolay* was formed by local Pittsburgh Masons dedicated to preparing young men to lead successful, happy, and productive lives.
