Proclamation congratulating the *Templar Chapter Order of DeMolay* upon its 100th Anniversary.

WHEREAS, the Templar Chapter Order of DeMolay is celebrating its 100th Anniversary of its founding this year; and

WHEREAS, the **Order of DeMolay** is an international youth organization sponsored by the Masonic fraternity that builds character and leadership skills in young men between the ages of 12 and 21; and

WHEREAS, **the Order of DeMolay** was founded in 1919 in Kansas City, Missouri, by a Kansas City area Mason, Frank S. Land, who selected the name to honor Jacques DeMolay, the last Grand Master of the Knights Templar in France; and

WHEREAS, the Templar Chapter Order of DeMolay was formed by local Pittsburgh Masons dedicated to preparing young men to lead successful, happy, and productive lives. This organization helps young men take part in a wide-range of activities, from athletic competitions, to public speaking tournaments, to community service events.
