Proclamation honoring *Chief Donald R. Dorsch* upon his retirement and for his 42 years of dedicated service to law enforcement.

WHEREAS, during his tenure at Franklin Park Police Department, *Chief Dorsch* became a member of several prestigious organizations: the Boroughs and Townships Police Association, the Allegheny County Chiefs of Police Association, the Western Pennsylvania Chief of Police Association, the Pennsylvania Chief of Police Association, the FBI National Academy Associates, the Allegheny County District Attorneys Narcotics Enforcement Task Force, the North Allegheny Police Partnership; and

WHEREAS, in his retirement, *Chief Dorsch* looks forward to spending time with his wife Cathy, son Michael and daughters Lori, Carrie and Jillian along with his eight grandchildren;
