Proclamation congratulating *Pastor Donald Blinn, Jr.* for his years dedicated to ministry services.

WHEREAS, through the years, *Pastor Blinn* has served to guide the church through decades of change - both in physical and changing congregational needs; and

WHEREAS, a dedicated family man, *Pastor Blinn* is married to his wife Kim Drum and together they have one son, Benjamin;
